Re: Tassomai homework

Tassomai is an online learning platform that forms a core part of homework for English, mathematics and science. Homework is set weekly on a Monday morning, and students are required to complete 3 'Daily Goals' for the following subjects:

- Year 7 – English, mathematics and science
- Year 8 – English, mathematics and science
- Year 9 – mathematics and science
- Year 10 and 11 – science only

It is important that your child completes their 'Daily Goals' in a timely manner. Study support clubs are available at lunchtime in all 3 subject areas where pupils can access computers to complete their homework. If your child misses their homework, they will be asked by their teacher to attend the study support club for a catch-up session. Failure to complete the homework and attend a consequent catch-up session will result in an after-school detention.

This week in lessons your child has been shown how to log-in, using their school email address and password 'QuizLearnGoal'. If your child cannot log-in, or has been unable to 'join' their relevant subject class, they should seek support from either their classroom teacher or by attending a lunchtime study support club.
